Date/time expected home: Sunday, June 13, after 8pm (will text and let you know better ETA)

INSTRUCTIONS

Meals and snacks: Supper time is around 7:30pm. Optionally, they can get breakfast in the morning, if they seem hungry.

Kibble is in the bins in the front closet. They get a scoop from either bin during the course of the day – so if they have breakfast, give them $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{1}{2}$ scoop, and then the rest of the scoop in the evening. (The scoop is a small round scoop in the bin.) At supper, add a few (3-5) carrots (bottom of the fridge), some milk or broth (door of the fridge) and top with some popcorn (beside the fridge). Put their bowls down for them to eat near to where you're sitting – they like to know what the people are doing. Nivis will probably try to steal Einstein's food a little, which is fair since Ein will finish off whatever Nivis doesn't eat.

They have two water bowls in the kitchen near the fridge. They drink a lot of water.

Treats are in the box on the dining room table and in the little bins in the closet with the empty kibble bin. Feel free to spoil them, but not to the point where they get sick, please.

Walk schedule: They like to walk every 4 - 6 hours. They tend to poop every time they are walked. Please make sure to pick up the poop and dispose of it. Extra poop bags are in the basket near the door with their harnesses, above the leashes.

Einstein uses the red harness and Nivis uses the gray harness. Use any leash you feel comfortable using.

Nivis does not get along with most other dogs. Einstein likes to go after cats and lady dogs (to sniff them – not hurt them). Nivis likes to eat cat poop; please don't let him.

Allergies: None

Medications: None

Hiding places: Under the beds – sunroom usually, but sometimes the master bedroom.

Favorite toys or games: Einstein loves to chase a ball; Nivis loves to chase Einstein. He also loves to play "chase" where we chase him around the coffee table. He also loves the purple mushroom toy filled with little treats, but only on carpet. There are toys in the living room, in the office (end of the hallway) next to the crates, in the treat box, and probably everywhere all over the floor.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Nivis will go potty in the hall bathroom. There are clean pads under the sink in that bathroom. Used paper ones go into the white diaper pail trash bin with a lid. On the sink, there's a basket with white rags and a spray bottle of cleaning solution to wipe up where he misses the pads. The dirty rags go into the metal trash bin with the lid. If the bottom cloth pad gets too stinky, put it in the metal bin, too, and pull out a clean one from under the sink. The trash bins should keep the stink contained reasonably well.

There are small balls in the gray treats bin – do not let them have these balls unsupervised as we worry that they are a choking hazard. But they do fit in the iFetch on the floor behind the couch, if you want to play with them. (Fire the ball down the hallway to the office. They won't bring the ball back.)

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION, CONTINUED...

If they get wet, there's a towel next to the harnesses to dry them.

They are fine to climb all over any of the furniture in the house.

You can use the gate in the hallway to block them out of spaces.

We have Google Home set up and connected to several lights and the thermostat. The lights will turn on automatically 1 hour before sunset. The lights in the library will turn off automatically at 2:00 am. You can tell Google to turn on/off lights and feel free to adjust the thermostat to your comfort.

Please feel free to make yourself at home – eat any of the food in the house. (We try not to give the dogs much "people food" especially directly from our plates when we're eating.) We have Netflix, Hulu, Disney+ and Amazon Prime for streaming options. And you're welcome to use the PS4 to play the games we've got. (There is another sheet with info for the electronics.)
